MPUMALANGA ANIMAL HEALTH CENTRES AND MOBILE HOSPITALS

Why should you bring your animals to the Animal Health Centres and mobile hospitals?

- They will receive regular check ups and examinations
- They will be vaccinated against regular diseases that affect them
- They will receive regular deworming
- Female pets can be spayed and males neutered so that they do not multiply unnecessarily
- They can be dipped for ticks, mites and fleas
- You can receive basic training on how to take care of your animals, how to feed them and how to recognize them when they are sick
- Your injured animals will receive treatments and operation if necessary
- You can receive information on various careers in Veterinary Science
- Your state veterinarian (Animal Doctor), veterinary nurse or animal health technician will attend to your animals for any other need



Which animals can be helped?

All pets, including dogs and cats. Other animals may be attended to. If you have animals that you cannot bring to the clinic like cattle and pigs ask if your attending official can be able to get to them.
