2018/19 BUDGET VOTE IN PICTURES

MEC VR Shongwe tabled the 2018/19 Budget Speech of over 1.1-billion Rand at the Legislature on 31 May 2018, in which he focused on the plans for the year ahead. He announced additional farms for the Fortune 40 Young Farmer Incubation Programme, the planned completion of Agri-Hubs, and plans to re-open the former Elijah Mango College as a Farmer Training Centre.

MEC Shongwe said the Department will continue with animal inspections, tests and vaccinations. On environmental issues, among others, the focus will also be the maintenance of the Air Quality Monitoring Stations in the Highveld Area.
