WE PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING SERVICES:

Promotion of Sustainable Resource Management

We provide support in the form of agricultural support services to farmers in order to ensure sustainable development and management of agricultural resources.

- Provide Agricultural Engineering Plans according to the needs of the beneficiaries in the province.
- Design agricultural engineering infrastructure for development according to Terms of Reference for project beneficiaries in the province
- Train Land-Care project beneficiaries on the sustainable use of natural resources
- · Provide projects with suitable infrastructure for livestock and crop production in Mpumalanga Province, based on business plans, Division of
- Revenue Act, and Land Care Programme · Improve and manage land by controlling invader plants and bush encroachment through soil conservation measures
- Support schools to practice sustainable use of natural resources • Distribute early warning information to the Stakeholders/ farmers.

Promotion of Farmer Support and Development (FSD)

We provide job creation, income generation and household food security through the implementation of commodity based projects funded through the Comprehensive Agricultural Support Programme (CASP), LandCare, Masibuyel`Esibayeni and the Masibuyel` Emasimini Pro-

Provision of Veterinary Services

- · Vaccinate the cattle for Communal farmers in Mpumalanga province against controlled animal diseases
- · Provide dipping for cattle using registered remedies annually in communal areas of the Province · Conduct Abattoir inspections in the Mpumalanga Province for Abattoir Owners as per protocol.
- · Conduct testing on animal and water samples, examine and perform necropsy on dead animals/organs as per the submission
- Attend to the requests for new Mpumalanga abattoirs · Conduct Illegal slaughter investigations while ensuring that safe and wholesome meat reaches the table of every citizen in Mpumalanga
- Issue Export certificates for exporters in Mpumalanga province

Execution of Technology Research and Development Services

We deal with agricultural research and the development and transfer of appropriate agricultural technologies. We conduct adaptive research to improve sustainable agricultural productivity and also to establish and strengthen research partnerships in agriculture sciences.
